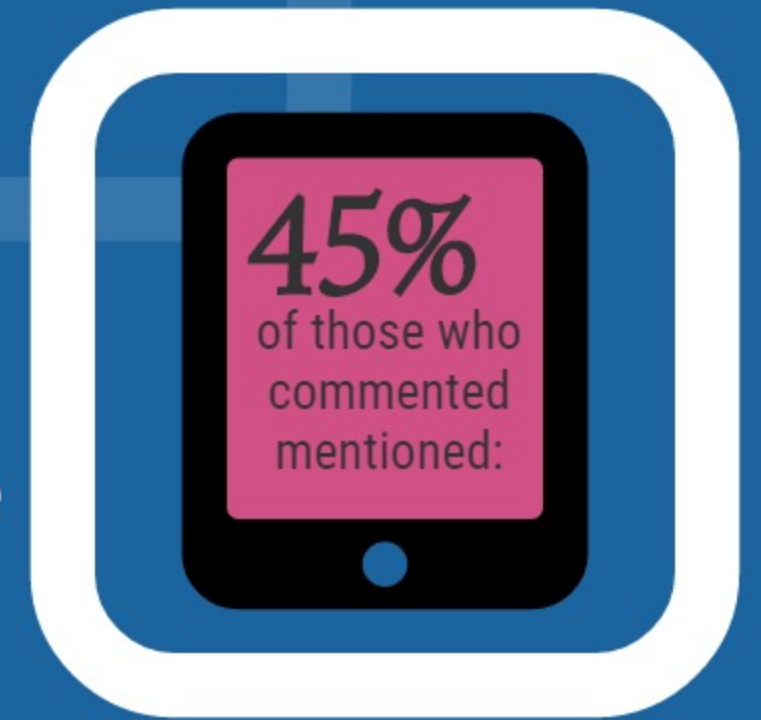
# WHAT YOU SAID

## Law Enforcement & Safety

Tioga County Partnership for Community Health County-wide "Building A Better Community" Survey qualitative data (administered May 2015.)

### Limited Law Enforcement Presence

**INCREASE POLICE ACCESSIBILITY.** More funds for full-time police. **ELECTED OFFICIALS SHOULD REMEDY LIMITED POLICE PRESENCE.** Required to use state police due to residence location. **LIMITED PRESENCE IN CERTAIN AREAS YIELDS MORE DRUG CRIME.** State police are spread too thin. **INCREASE ACCOUNTABILITY.** Need regional police force. **REDUCE RESPONSE TIME TO EMERGENCIES.** Monitor traffic better.



### Safety Issues

**THREATENED BY DRUG CRIME.** Lack of sidewalks in certain areas. **SPEEDING VEHICLES.** Theft. **LACK OF POLICE ACCESSIBILITY AND AVAILABILITY DECREASE SAFETY.** Lots of accidents on neighborhood street.

### Drug Crime

**MORE FUNDING TO BATTLE ILLEGAL ACTIVITY.** Increasing in the area. **THREATENS COMMUNITY SAFETY.** Huge problem. **ADDITIONAL POLICE (NARCAN) TRAINING TO REDUCE DRUG CRIME.** Increase prevention and intervention measures.



### Miscellaneous

**MORE SUPPORT FOR FIRE AND EMS (FINANCIAL).** Increase accountability for re-offenders. **STRICTER LICENSE RENEWAL PROCEDURES FOR OLDER ADULTS AND SUBSTANCE ABUSERS.** Employ security guards during school hours. **INCREASE FUNDING FOR POLICE TRAINING.**
