Service Accessibility and Materials

OPEN UP RECYCLING DROP OFF 24/7. Include pick-up recycling. INCONSISTENT OR NO RECYCLING PICK-UP. Open up recycling facility at easier location (provide more jobs). COLLECT IN ONE CONTAINER, INSTEAD OF SORTED.

Services Outside of Borough

NO SERVICES OFFERED OUT OF TOWN FOR TRASH. No door-to-door recycling services offered outside of borough. SHOULD BE AVAILABLE IN EVERY COMMUNITY/ RURAL AREAS. No recycling in Knoxville, Rutland, Union (south) or Lawrence Township.

Clear Guidelines and Awareness

MAKE IT CLEAR WHAT TO RECYCLE PROPERLY. Picky about what take and do not take (wet/ dirty). WANT MORE ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY COMMUNITY. Recycling education/ opportunities need COLLECT IN ONE CONTAINER, INSTEAD OF SORTED to be promoted.
